- Students will write **5 provincial graduation exams** in Language Arts 10, Mathematics 10, Science 10, Social Studies 11 and Language Arts 12. (⌘ = provincial exam)
- Students will be assessed on a **Graduation Transition Plan** worth 4 credits demonstrating Work Experience, Physical Activity, Transition Plan plus their **Interview**.
