**Total – 80 credits Grade 10-12**

- A **Fine Arts** or an **Applied Skills** course must be completed in Grade 10, 11 or 12.
- A minimum of **16 credits** are required **at the Grade 12 level**, including Language Arts.
- Students will write **5 provincial graduation exams** in Language Arts 10, Mathematics 10, Science 10, Social Studies 11 and Language Arts 12. (⌘ = provincial exam)
- Students will be assessed on a **Graduation Transition Plan** worth 4 credits demonstrating Work Experience, Physical Activity, Transition Plan plus their **Interview**.
